Community Cupboards

Brentwood Free Little Pantry (4.5km) – Free Pantries are food by neighbors for neighbors and donating culturally relevant foods has a positive impact on those receiving it. These pantries are open 24/7. No ID is required, and anyone is welcome to give and receive food from them.

- **Eligibility:** Anyone
- **Hours:** 24/7
- **Address:** 3624 Boulton Rd NW

Kensington Commons Church (5.4 km) – Community Cupboard of non-perishable food, warm clothing, and child/baby items such as diapers and formula. Everything in the cupboard is free and available to anyone 24/7.

- **Eligibility:** Anyone
- **Frequency:** As needed
- **Hours:** 24/7
- **Phone:** (877) 360-0365 (Church main number)
- **Address:** Kensington Commons Church - 2404 Kensington Road NW. Community Cupboard is located on the south side of the church, right beside the south entrance.

Fish Creek United Church (22.9 km) – Offers several programs to promote food security, such as establishing a free pantry, Cobbs Bread Giveaway every Thursdays, Good Food Box distribution, and a Calgary Food Bank Satellite Depot. Fish Creek is also an authorized referral agency for Calgary Food Bank and can assist people in ordering hampers.

- **Eligibility:** Anyone
- **Frequency:** The free pantry is accessible from Monday to Thursday at 9:00am – 12:00pm & 1:00 pm – 4:00 pm

Food Hampers, General

Foodbank Outreach Association (8.0 km) – Clients can go to their food bank on Monday and Thursday mornings from 9:00 am – 11:30 am but will need to arrange for pickup by calling (403)-288-6330.

- **Eligibility:** Anyone
- **Frequency:** 6 pickups per family per year. (No restrictions on family size)
- **Hours:** Mondays and Thursdays 9:00am-11:30am

Salvation Army – Barbara Mitchell Family Resource Center (8.1 km) – Clients can select certain food they would like, like shopping at a grocery store. (Only on certain days depending on when they have volunteers so have to always call before going). **Appointment based, establish a pick-up point for a food bank.**

- **Eligibility:** Anyone ideally, but typically low income and those who suffer with homelessness
- **Frequency:** Appointment Based/Walkin Pantry

- **Notes:** Call before going they operate if their volunteers are available.

Aboriginal Friendship Center (8.7 km) – Offers hampers to mainly unhoused individuals. Hampers are not as big as they used to be.

- **Eligibility:** Mostly for unhoused people, but students are eligible as well.
- **Frequency:** Gives food hamper every Tuesday. Hampers are in low quantity so they will be in stock until they run out and the center refills the hampers every Tuesday. Must pick up and fill out paper forms.

- **Notes:** Patrons must go through the Source doors as the center does not have their own doors.

Salvation Army Centre of Hope (10.6 km) – Offers emergency food hampers suitable for individuals and families.

- **Frequency:** Once a month
- **Hours:** Appointment for pickup:

- Monday to Friday from 9 AM to 4:30 PM
- The office is closed from 12 PM to 1 PM

- **Notes:** They are in the process of moving to Forest Lawn location as well in the next 3 months or so. (2236 35 St SE)

Sunrise Community Link Resource Centre (15.0 km) – An agency working towards poverty reduction.

- **Eligibility:** Open to anyone who needs a food hamper
- **Frequency:** Pick up Mondays and Thursdays at 1:00pm-4:00pm, if there is an emergency contact their number to set up an appointment

Dashmesh Culture Centre (16.4 km) – Provides hot meals and non-perishable goods for takeout daily.

- **Eligibility:** Food hampers don't need to be pre-ordered but can be for convenience. There are no eligibility requirements, just an honor system for whomever is in need.
- **Frequency:** As often as necessary
- **Hours:** Foodbank: Monday – Sunday, 12:00pm-4:00pm / Hot meals and non-perishable take-out: 9:00am-9:00pm daily

Robert McClure United Church Food Pantry (17.9 km) – pre-assembled, non-perishable food hampers are available as well as a selection of perishable items, such as bread, fruit and vegetables, meat and dairy products. One individual from each household may pickup a hamper outside the church (inside in the winter).

- **Eligibility:** Anyone; they do not screen participants or require referrals or appointments
- **Frequency:** Thursdays
- **Hours:** 12:00 pm – 2:00 pm

Calgary Food Bank (18.6 km) – Provides hampers every 10 days. There is no limit to how many hampers a person can get. Has a variety of ways to pick up hamper (see “Notes”).

- **Eligibility:** Households are eligible to access a food hamper once every 10 days. To receive a food hamper, we ask for the full name, birthdate, and a unique ID number from each member of the household. We also ask for current address, phone number, and information about the household's income and expenses for the past 30 days. We do not require documentation but ask these questions to ensure that our resources are going towards people in need.

 - Has the option of a drive thru hamper pick-up or curbside pick up
 - There is a safe and secure QR code so friends and family can pick up your hamper

Victory Outreach (Eastside) (18.8 km) – Provides an emergency hamper, food bank hampers, hot meals, & more. A Calgary Food Bank Depot.

- **Eligibility:** Any resident of Calgary
- **Frequency:** The same as the Calgary Food Bank
- **Hours:** 12:00pm to 1:30pm on Tuesday, Wednesdays, & Thursdays for Food Bank services & 12:00pm to 1:30pm for other resources

Society of St. Vincent de Paul (several locations in Calgary’s quadrants) – The program is locally managed; each location has their own program which serves their immediate

Abundant Life Church's Bread-Basket Program (10.0 km) – Provides hampers through appointment and registration.

- **Eligibility:** Service offered to residents in southwest Calgary living in:
 - South of Spruce Drive, North of Glenmore Trail, West of 14 Street.
- **Frequency:** Pick up by appointment on Thursdays between 12:00 PM and 12:30 PM

 - We require ID and proof of address on the first visit. Participants may come up to 2 times per month, depending on food availability.
 - We have a \$1 service fee (this helps us pay for access to the warehouse where we get our food), but it is waived if a person does not have it on any given week.
 - Enter parking lot on the East side and drive around to the West side. Volunteers will put the hamper in the car.
 - For participants walking or taking transit, we recommend bringing a cart (some people use wheeled suitcases) or bags.
 - We are wheelchair accessible. Has a service fee of \$1.00 per food box
 - Bring your own bags
 - Registration is required upon first visit
 - Drive into parking lot and follow orange pylons to door
 - People on foot will need their own cart or bags

The Genesis Centre (19.0 km) – Calgary Food Bank Hamper pick-up: Tuesdays and Wednesdays 10am-11:30am (must call the Calgary Food Bank at 403-253-2055 to request a hamper and specify that you would like to pick it up at the Genesis Centre). Appointment based, need to contact the number first.

- **Eligibility:** please see Calgary Food Bank information, appointment based, must contact Food Bank first
- **Frequency:** the same as the Calgary Food Bank
- **Hours:** for hamper pickup – Tuesdays & Wednesdays from 10am to 11:30am

Al-Qaim Foundation (19.6 km) – No-cost food hampers for seniors and Calgarians in quarantine, financial need or in self-isolation. Call-in service. Delivery available.

- **Eligibility:** Can request a food hamper if in financial need however, the board will determine eligibility of the individual based on their criteria
- **Frequency:** As needed & by request
- **Hours:** Food hamper pickup or delivery would be determined in response to request inquiry if eligible

The Hope Mission (19.8 km) – Provides food hampers for families with minors only within the Southeast area. Clients need to call or email for an appointment. Also provides free community meals monthly. (The next meals will be provided on November 18 and December 16 at 4:30 – 7:00 pm). Clients who are interested in getting a community meal must call or email in advance.

- **Eligibility:** For families; only provides hampers for families with dependents under 18 years of age.
- **Frequency:** pickup is held every Thursday within office hours monthly through appointments.

Abbeydale Christian Fellowship Community Outreach (21.2 km) – Provides a weekly drop-in food cupboard service with surplus items donated by local grocery stores.

- **Eligibility:** Available to those either living within the communities of Abbeydale, Applewood, or Penbrooke, or attending the Abbeydale Christian Fellowship Church, or Love in Action Church. Proof of address is required in order to pick up.
- **Frequency:** As often as needed
- **Hours:** Pickups are every Tuesday from 5:00-5:30 PM (During the summer, pickups will be held biweekly)

Canopy Society (Calgary Emergency Food Hamper) (various locations throughout Calgary) – Delivery of emergency food hampers to seven depots in Calgary for pick-up by families and individuals who have requested a hamper by calling the Food Bank’s Hamper Request Line.

If a client receives government assistance or Child Tax Benefit, proof of those also needs to be shown.

- **Eligibility:** Anyone, although this food bank is targeted towards individuals requiring a Halal diet.

Student Wellness Services (University of Calgary) – Offers President’s Choice gift cards, redeemable at any Loblaw’s banner store (Superstore).

Referrals from around campus will also be accepted. When applying for a grocery card a student must provide the following information, in addition to their Unicard:

 - Information related to living situation, marital status, family size, and whether they are an international/domestic student
 - Financial resources including applications to other types of financial aid, student loans, employment income, savings etc.
